**Fun-Frolic Activities:**

<p><b><u>Show and tell at home:</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Materials:</u></b> Use common household objects like hat/cap, favourite dress, doll, jug, cycle, books etc.</p> <p><b><u>Instructions:</u></b> Encourage your child to make simple sentences to describe the object.</p>	<p><b><u>Blowing Bubbles:</u></b></p> <p><b><u>Materials:</u></b> Bubble water or soapy water solution, shallow dish and a straw.</p> <p><b><u>Instructions:</u></b> Understanding air and blowing bubbles is a super duper fun. Place the solution in a shallow dish and give the kids a straw to blow bubbles.</p>

<p><b><u>Father's Day Special</u></b>  <b><u>(Make a pen stand for your Father)</u></b>  <u>Materials:</u> Toothpaste box, pastel sheet, passport size photograph of your Father, circle cutout.</p> <p><u>Instructions:</u> Help your child to wrap a fluorescent pastel sheet around an empty big size toothpaste box. Paste a circular cutout on its top with a passport size photograph of his/her father on it.</p>	<p><b><u>Shape Island</u></b>  <u>Materials:</u> Objects related to 4 basic shapes eg. Bindis, cap, dice etc.  <u>Instructions:</u> Allow your child to explore his/her surrounding and collect different objects related to 4 basic shapes i.e. Circle, Square, Rectangle, Triangle. Help your child to create their shape island in a room. Those objects child can store in a well decorated utility box which will be used after holidays for class discussion.</p>

**Everyday activities:**

- **Walk together** - Get up early in the morning and see the rising sun and go for a Nature Walk with your parents.
  - **Etiquettes and Manners** - Remember to use magical words like **Thank You, Sorry, Please** and **Excuse Me** in your daily conversation.
  - **Play Outdoor Games** - Computer games are good and they sharpen your intellect but your body needs some exercises. In the evening time go out and play some outdoor games in a nearby park with your friends.
  - **Conversation** - Try to converse in English with your family members and friends.
  - **Beat the heat** - Always eat healthy food and drink lots of fluids to beat the heat of the sun like lemonade, butter milk, shakes, juices etc.
  - **Guidelines for watching T.V.** - Do not watch T.V. for more than 2 hours a day. Try to watch programs on channels like Discovery or National Geographic to Enhance your knowledge.

## Projects:

### ENGLISH

- **Reading story books** enhances language and vocabulary development. Make bedtime ritual to read a storybook with your child daily for 10-15 minutes. Talk to them about the pictures and the story.
- To improve pronunciation and speech clarity of your child search for some **Tongue Twisters** (simple and easy) on internet. Help your little ones to learn 2 to 3 Tongue Twisters. Example:  
"She Sells Sea Shells, On the Sea Shore!!"
- **Picture Talk Card**: On an A-3 size sheet draw a scene on the following topic (as per your section):
  1. Pre-Primary A      Birthday Party Scene
  2. Pre-Primary B      Garden Scene
  3. Pre-Primary C      Market Scene
  4. Pre-Primary D      Hill Station Scene
  5. Pre-Primary E      Forest Scene
  6. Pre-Primary F      Sea Beach Scene

To make it attractive use water colors, foam sheet cutouts, glitters etc. Get this sheet laminated so that it can be use for picture talk by your child in class after holidays.

### Hindi

- On an A-4 size light color sheet, draw one big, bold and colorful picture of **each Vyanjan** according to your Roll No. Slot given below:
