CREATIVITY WEEK: An exciting amalgamation of thoughts, ideas, talent and opportunities is to be celebrated once again. A week full of activities, which aims at providing our students with a platform to showcase their talent and skills. The week will be celebrated from 26th November 2018 to 30th November 2018. This year Creativity Week will be a bit different as one half will be devoted to competitive activities and the other will have some fun filled non-competitive activities.

Participation in all the activities is compulsory. You are requested to inspire and motivate your ward for the same. The schedule for **Class 4** will be as follows:-

CLASS IV

COMPETITION/EVENT

26th Nov 2018

1. MOSAIC TILE DESIGNING

- Students will cut different shapes using craft papers, paste them on a square card board to design a mosaic tile.
- Material : Craft papers, Square cardboard (16"x16"), fevicol and scissors.
- It is an individual activity.
- Time Limit – 1 ½ hour
- Judgement criteria: Creativity, Concept, Presentation and Neatness.

2. PLEASURE TRIP

- Students will be taken to a nearby park for a picnic.
- Various games and activities will be organized to facilitate learning outside the realms of a classroom.
- Time duration- School hours

27th Nov 2018

1. (a) INTEGRATED QUIZ

- A quiz based on Academics and General Awareness.
- It is a team event.
- Four students from each class will be selected after a preliminary round on 20.11.2018.
- Duration: 1 ½ hour

(b) NEWS IN USE

- Students will make the most obvious use of old new paper to make any crafty item.
- It is an individual event.
- Judgment criteria: Neatness, Creativity, Innovation and Presentation.
- Time limit: 1 ½ hour.

Note- Students participating in 'Integrated Quiz' will not take part in 'News In Use'.

2. FOOD FIESTA – Children can buy and relish hygienically packed food.

28th Nov 2018

1. ULHAAS PARV

- Students of class IV will give a stage presentation.
- Theme- Celebrating Indian Festivals.
- Costumes and props as required and instructed by the teacher.

2. (a) DEBATE

- Four students (two pairs) from each section will be selected after the preliminary round on 23.11.2018.
- The topics are: Health is Wealth, Environment V/S Man, Technology V/S Conventional ways.
- Pair activity.
- Judgment Criteria- Confidence, Presentation, Expression, Content, Fluency, Relevance, Synchronization.
- Costume: Formals
- Duration- 2-3 minutes each including introduction.

(b) I DESIGN WHAT I SELL

- The students will make an advertisement of any product of daily use. It should be an original idea and not copied from any existing product.
- Required Material: A4 size Pastel sheet, clip board, crayons, sketch pens etc.
- Judgement Criteria: Presentation, Creativity, Originality.
- Time Duration: 1 ½ Hour.

Note- Students participating in 'Debate' will not take part in 'I Design What I Sell' .

1(a) CHROMA CANVAS

- Students will recreate the given picture as per their creativity and knowledge of tools in Tux Paint.
- Four students from each class will be selected after a preliminary round on 20th and 21st November 2018.
- It is an individual activity.
- Software: Tux Paint
- Judgment Criteria – Neatness, Creativity, and tools used.
- Duration- 1 ½ hours

(b) YOUNG VAIGYANIK

- Students will make any one science project with waste material of their choice.
- It is an individual event.
- Judgment Criteria- Concept, Creativity, Innovation, application.
- Time Limit-1 ½Hours.

Note- Students participating in ‘Chroma Canvas’ will not take part in ‘Young Vaigyanik’

2. FROM THE PALETTE OF A SRESHTHA

- Individual noncompetitive drawing and colouring activity.
- The topic will be given on the spot.
- All the required material: labeled drawing sheet, clip board, crayons and sketch pen for outlining will be brought by the students.

30th Nov 2018

1. (a) AAMNE SAAMNE

- The interviewer will take interview of any celebrity in Hindi.
- Four students (two pairs) from each section will be shortlisted after the preliminary round on 22.11.2018.
- It is a pair activity.
- Judgment Criteria- Confidence, fluency, coordination and synchronization.
- Costume: Formals
- Time Limit- 2 to 3 minutes (including introduction)

(b) CHITRA KATHA

- Students will make a Chitra katha (Comic Strip) on any topic.
- Students will depict the story through pictures and caption.
- It is an individual event.
- Material Required- As per requirement.
- Time Limit: 1 ½ Hrs.

Note- Students participating in 'Aamne Saamne' will not take part in 'Chitra Katha'

2. KAARYSHALA

- To encourage learning while doing a workshop will be conducted by teachers on varied topics from Arts and crafts to Music and Dance moves.
- Material Required- Origami sheets, Drawing sheet, Crayons, Clay etc.
