### Respected Parents

On Sunday, the 10<sup>th</sup> of January 2016 the school shall be organizing a function “ Aao Sansaar Sukhi Banayein”.

This function is an initiative of the Arya Pradeshik Pratinidhi Sabha, Maharashtra under the aegis of APP Sabha, New Delhi of which the Honourable President of DAVCMC, Dr. Punam Suri ji is the President.

Rooted firmly on the principles of values and morals, the APP Sabha has been tirelessly working towards bringing quality into individual and social life by engaging in major social activities across the country that unite people bringing peace, harmony and happiness into their lives and everywhere.

The programme “ Aao Sansaar Sukhi Banayein” is one such major initiative.

All the teachers and other staff members of all DAV Schools in the Western Region (Maharashtra and Gujarat) shall be participating in this event.

**The ground capacity being limited and for safety and security reasons only the parents of Classes III to XII are invited to this programme.**

And from a family only the parents or any 2 persons shall attend the programme. Bringing small children and very elderly people shall strictly be avoided.

**The highlights of the function shall be the Peace Message of the Honourable President Dr. Punam Suri, President DAVCMC New Delhi; President APP Sabha New Delhi; Chancellor DAV University, Jalandhar Punjab and a Ballet on the Life and Works of Maharishi Swami Dayanand Saraswati and Bhajans rendered by students of various DAV Schools in the region as well as the honouring of Vedic Scholars and Sanyasis from different parts of the country.**

**A few guidelines of safety and security are given here for strict and serious consideration and follow up of all of us.**

1. Parents shall sit as per the direction of the volunteers at the venue. The volunteers are our own students, teachers and PTA members.
2. The staff of the school shall be busy in many ways with the programme. Please do not enter into any discussion or argument with them or trouble them unnecessarily. Be patient, understanding, and tolerant and let's solve our problems on our own to the extent possible.

3. Please do not bring your vehicles. It would be faster, easier, trouble free and peaceful if you walk down to school and walk back home after the programme. Or you may resort to public transport. However, in case you bring your vehicle please **park them away, far away from the school**. All roads around the school building are marked **NO PARKING ZONES**. **Please follow this instruction very strictly**.
4. The ground capacity is limited. Please do not bring along anyone else however dear a relative, neighbour or a friend may be.
5. No one whosoever shall come forward towards the stage in any manner to shoot videos or click stills while the programme is in progress. You will not be allowed. However, in case you are interested in photos and videos of your child's performance, they shall be available at the school after a week's time.
6. As a parent please remember that you have a crucial role in ensuring discipline, peace and order at the venue and around, and contribute in every way possible for the success of the programme and well being of all.


**Regarding participating students**

- If your child is participating in any event or in certain capacity as a volunteer or whatever, please send along with your child enough food and water. Similarly avoid giving money. Food may be difficult to get or money may not be safe. The school canteen shall also remain closed.
- Costly cell phones and all valuables, avoid sending with your ward, whatever class he/she may be in. Or ask them to take care of themselves. Blame no one.
- If your ward is grown up enough and responsible, ask him/her to come to school and go back on their own. This can avoid more people inside the school building and thus avoid congestion.
- Children of all classes shall ensure that their name, class and division are written with marker pen on all their belongings including water bottle, tiffin, school bag etc. Also they must necessarily wear their school identity cards even if they are in their different costumes.
- Avoid all curiosity to stop and talk to a teacher or to a staff member. Remember, everyone is too busy and occupied with different programmes, children and other varied important responsibilities.

**The school shall be closed on Friday, 08<sup>th</sup> January as well as on Monday 11<sup>th</sup> January. Classes shall be compensated later with Saturdays as working.**

**Your benign and invaluable presence dear parents, shall be our greatest honour, strength and fortitude to cherish all along the programme as well as throughout our life. Kindly be on your seats by 4.45 p.m. sharp at the school ground. The function will not delayed in any way whatsoever since the Honourable President as well as other important Office Bearers of DAV College Managing Committee, New Delhi shall be present in the school hours ahead of the programme.**
